Unapproved Council Minutes August 2018

Council members present: Kate Andal, Mark Bidne, Diane Hofer, Amanda Hyronimus, Carolyn DeRaad, Marilyn Carlson Aronson and Valerie Anderson. Pastor Greg Myrmoe was also present. Kate Andal called the meeting to order.

Pastor Myrmoe led in devotions.

June and July secretary minutes were reviewed. Motion was made to approve, and motion was carried.

June and July treasurer's reports were reviewed. Motion was made to approve, and motion was carried.

Grace Doeden is the recipient of a \$500 scholarship from the Lutheran College fund. Grace currently attends Augustana University.

Motion was made and was carried approving the bell choir director, Shelley Jensen, to be paid \$1,200 per year.

New Business

Discussion was held on a need for having funds available and designated for church property repairs and maintenance. \$100 per month will be put toward savings for church property repairs and maintenance; \$100 per month will go toward savings for parsonage repairs and maintenance. In 2016 the capitol campaign fund borrowed \$11,000 from the parsonage account; \$5,500 will now be moved from the capitol campaign account back into the parsonage savings.

Discussion was held on church member attendance and involvement.

Old Business

Tickets for the 125th Anniversary catered meal are being sold after worship services.

The Beresford Republic newspaper has been contacted on writing a story on Emmanuel's 125th Anniversary.

Posting of Emmanuel's available church secretary position will be placed in the bulletin.

Christian Education- Emmanuel t-shirt sales continue. Emmanuel youth participated in vacation bible school at the city park last week. Sunday school teachers for this year are needed.

WELCA – The church basement was cleaned and painted. Volunteers will be needed to help clean the Narthex. Members are putting together church history and photos to be displayed for the 125th Anniversary. Members will be working on table decorations. Chair donations for the basement continue.

Music and Worship- The next meeting will be 8/26/18 at 8:30 am. The piano and organ will be tuned before the 125th Anniversary. Repairs were made to the organ on June 7. 125th Anniversary Celebration invitations were sent to former Emmanuel pastors; former pastors present will give short greetings during the service. Bell choir rehearsal will be 8/22/18, senior choir will rehearse 8/29/18.

Parish Health- Members have been motivated with prizes to complete summer challenges. In September, guest speakers will resume Parish education between worship services. The Bloodmobile will be at Emmanuel on 11/11/18.

Properties- Landscaping was weeded, sacristy sink was replaced, light bulbs were replaced and a door in the education unit was repaired. The basement bathroom by the kitchen was painted.

Pastor's Report- Pictures of the church will be taken. Marilyn Carlson Aronson will fill in on 8/26/18.

Meeting adjourned and closed with The Lord's Prayer.
